This year the Senior Center Advisory Committee is partnering with Youth Advisory Committee to help with the pre-planning of this event.

7.3 Senior Center Marquee

Meghan Tiernan, Parks and Facilities Development Coordinator presented the Advisory Committee Members an overview of the project. Staff is exploring the installation of a marquee and the study is in the preliminary stages of researching location, cost, vendors, and partnership with the Senior Center Foundation.

George Zika, Senior Center Foundation representative stated the Foundation is asking the City for cost estimates on both locations, coloring and who will pay for the upkeep of the marquee.
