**7.1 2015 Winter Quarterly Report**

Carol McGeary of the Senior Center Foundation mentioned the Foundation had been discussing the marquee. They will be considering a contribution to the cost of the marquee. The Youth Fee Assistance Benefit Concert will be held April 12, 2015 at 2:00 PM with a suggested donation of \$6. The activity is being promoted at the high schools and on the City website.
