



WHAT IS THE CITY OF DUBLIN'S COMMUNITY ACTION TEAM?

The City of Dublin's Community Action Team consists of staff members from various departments within the City. The team's purpose is to preserve the integrity of the community, ensure compliance with Dublin Codes and Regulations, and to protect the public health, safety, and welfare of the City.

ANIMAL ISSUES

- Problems with rats, flies, pigeons, or other pests; contact Alameda County Vector Control at 510-567-6800.
- Problems with mosquitoes and/or dirty swimming pools; contact Alameda County Mosquito Abatement at 510-783-7744.
- Problems with dogs barking or running loose; contact Animal Control at 925-803-7042.



GRAFFITI ISSUES

The City of Dublin has adopted an ordinance that declares the existence of graffiti to be a public nuisance. The ordinance addresses graffiti that is visible from public property, adjacent to private property or those areas generally accessible to the public and is not voluntarily removed by the owner or tenant. Crews from the City's Public Works Department remove graffiti that occurs on public property. Graffiti on private property is the responsibility of the property owner.

ZONING ENFORCEMENT ISSUES

The Code Enforcement Officer enforces all Zoning and Property Maintenance Ordinances. Enforcement is provided on a complaint basis through the Planning Division. The City will respond to possible ordinance violations if a formal complaint is filed. Per State law, all complainant information is kept confidential. Be aware, especially difficult issues may require several phone calls, site visits and/or letters before violations are corrected.

PROPERTY MAINTENANCE ISSUES

- Abandoned cars on public streets should be referred to the Dublin Police Department at 925-462-1212.
- Abandoned cars on private property, please contact Code Enforcement at

925-833-6610.

Problems with weeds, dead, decayed, diseased or unsightly vegetation that is dangerous to public health, safety, and welfare of the City, contact the appropriate departments as follows:

- Overgrown green vegetation contact Code Enforcement at 925-833-6610.
- Weeds on private property contact Dublin Fire Prevention at 925-833-6606.
- Unsightly vegetation on public property contact the Public Works Department at 925-833-6630.

BUILDING ISSUES

BUILDING PERMITS

The following residential permits are issued over the counter:

- Water softeners
- Water heaters
- AC units
- Residential reroof
- Portable spa (must meet setback requirements)
- Lawn sprinklers – backflow preventor
- Window replacements

Permits can be issued Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Inspections can be scheduled Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
