


MEET THE LENDERS

Reusable Bag Ordinance - Potential Expansion

In 2012, the Alameda County Waste Management Authority, also known as StopWaste, adopted a Plastic Bag Ordinance prohibiting the use of single-use bags at most retailers selling packaged food. Alameda County is now considering expansion of the Reusable Bag Ordinance to cover additional retail stores, potentially including all retail stores and restaurants in Alameda County.

StopWaste will be hosting a series of meetings throughout the county to solicit your input on expansion ideas and the reusable bag

requirements. These sessions are open to all retailers located in Alameda Country:

- Pleasanton | October 19, 2015
- Union City | October 27, 2015
- Oakland | October 29, 2015
