Men's 5-on-5 "D" - Sunday Basketball League



The City of Dublin is offering an Adult Men's 5-on-5 "D" level Spring basketball league. Resident teams may register in person at the Shannon Community Center at 11600 Shannon Avenue in Dublin on Mondays – Fridays from 8:00 am – 5:00 pm. Non-Resident teams may register in person at the Shannon Center or online at www.dublinrecguide.com

On www.dublinrecguide.com, If creating an account for the first time, please create a "Team" not a "Family" account. Leagues are visible by selecting the tab "Search/Register" then "League Search".

Teams will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Spring teams will be added after **April 22** only if space is available and then a **\$25 late registration fee will apply**.

REGISTRATION WILL REQUIRE:

1) A completed registration form. Also, all individual players will be asked to complete a **Player Waiver and Release Form** once during the calendar year. The Player Waiver and Release Form and House Rules are available on the City's website (www.dublin.ca.gov) or emailed out by request to robert.beasley@dublin.ca.gov

2) Complete payment of the fees. No partial payments accepted. Checks made payable to "City of Dublin."

A uniform requirement is in effect; Reversible jerseys are preferred. Permanent numbers only (no tape).

LEAGUE FORMAT:

Sunday league games times will be scheduled in late afternoon and early evening. All games will be played at **Stager Community Gymnasium, 6901 York Drive**.

Please note: Each league consists of an six game regular season with the top teams advancing to single elimination playoffs. A minimum of 50% of the teams will qualify for the playoffs. However, the league format is subject to change depending on registration.

<u>LEAGUE FEES:</u>	\$504 for Resident teams	\$605 for Non-Resident teams
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Resident/Non Resident Status:

To qualify as a resident team: 51% of the roster must be Dublin residents or must be sponsored by a Dublin based business with a current business license and pay by company check or credit card. Resident team registration must be done in person at the Dublin Senior Center, not online.
