Aaron and Dillon can be found seated on a bench at the back of the City Hall courtyard. This life-size ceramic sculpture of a father tying his young son's shoe is by the same artist who sculpted Gail, the ceramic woman who now sits on a bench just inside the entrance of City Hall. It was created to take Gail's spot in the courtyard when she was relocated indoors. The piece was created from a candid photograph of the artist Katherine Keefer's son Aaron and grandson Dillon. Katherine Keefer began her career in 1973 and has created public art for cities in Northern California and nationally. She won a prestigious "Americans for the Arts" Award for her work for the West Regional Library in Broward County, Florida.
