Congratulations Snowflake Inc.

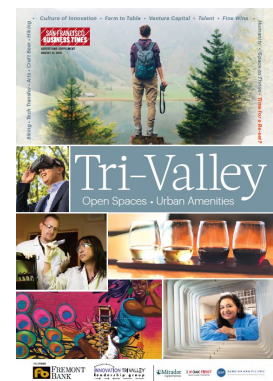
