



Microbusiness & Non-Profit Grants Available May 17 through August 12, 2022

The California Office of the Small Business Advocate (CalOSBA) has awarded funding to the Chabot Las Positas Community College District (CLPCCD) to provide grants to microbusinesses in the counties of Alameda, Amador, Contra Costa, and El Dorado.

The program will provide grants of \$2,500 to microbusinesses (businesses earning less than \$50,000/year with less than five employees) that were in operation in 2019, are still in operation, and were impacted by the pandemic.

ABC Mandatory Responsible Beverage Service Training Deadline 8/31/22



Starting July 1, 2022, any on-premise alcohol service and manager must have a valid [Responsible Beverage Service \(RBS\)](#) certification from an Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) accredited RBS training provider and pass an online ABC administered RBS exam within 60 calendar days from the first date of employment.

[RBS training](#) educates persons seeking employment or who are currently employed as servers of alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption. RBS training aims to provide servers the necessary skills to responsibly serve alcoholic beverages and mitigate alcohol-related harm in California communities.
