The City of Dublin Small Business Navigator Program Provides a Valuable Resource

The City of Dublin's **Small Business Navigator Program** provides small businesses with access to qualified service providers in key functional areas, such as business planning

and development; marketing and advertising; architecture and space design; technology consulting; and more. The program also provides legal services; human resources and management; financial guidance; and other general services.

To be eligible for the program, businesses must have a brick-and-mortar location in the City of Dublin, possess an active City business license, have fewer than 50 full-time employees, and be independently owned. Requests will be reviewed on a first-come, first-served basis, and accepted on a rolling basis until program funding has been exhausted. Applications are now being accepted.

California Competes Application Window Now Open

The California Competes Tax Credit (CCTC) is an income tax credit available to businesses that want to locate in California or stay and grow in California. Businesses of any industry, size, or location compete for over \$180 million available in tax credits by applying in one of the three application periods each year. Applicants will be analyzed based on fourteen different factors of evaluation, including number of full-time jobs being created, amount of investment, and strategic importance to the state or region.


The first application period started on July 24, 2023, with \$164 million in tax credits and \$120 million in grants available. For the Grant Program (CCGP), priority will be given for applicants whose grant will be used to secure federal CHIPS funding. The online application can be accessed [here](#).
