## Citizen Self Service—Searching for an Application

The Citizen Self-Service (CSS) Portal gives customers several methods for finding online applications. This guide walks you through applying from the [Home Page Tiles](#) and the [Top Menu Banner](#).

**\*\*You must be logged in to your CSS account to apply for any permit, plan, or license.**

### From the Home Page Tiles

1. Click the **Apply** tile on the Home page.



This tool can be used to apply for a permit, plan, business license, or professional license.

- a. **OPTION 1** – Click the **Show Categories** link and then “All” will reveal categories to further organize the online applications into their appropriate subheadings. Clicking these items will display available applications in the results window.

- b. **OPTION 2** – Selecting one of the tabs at the top will display all applications for that main category in alphabetical order.



- c. **OPTION 3** – If you know the name of the application, typing in the search box will reveal an auto-populated drop-down list of the applications including what you typed.



# Citizen Self Service—Searching for an Application

From the “Apply” button on the Banner

1. Click the **Apply** button on the banner.



2. A menu will open with 3 categories: Permits, Plans, and Licenses.
  - a. Beneath the categories will list 5 of the available applications.
  - b. At the bottom of the list will be an option to view “All” the applications in that category.
  - c. The number in parenthesis next to the “All” refers to the number of available applications in that category.
  - d. If you see the application you are looking for in the list of 5 you can go ahead and click on it and the application will open.
  - e. If you do not see the application you need, click the “All” option at the bottom to open the full list of applications in the category.
