

**Argument in Favor of
Dublin Traffic Relief, Clean Air/Open Space Preservation Measure**

Help connect Dublin and Livermore, reduce traffic, and preserve wildlife/ open space at NO cost to taxpayers, vote Yes on X!

For over a decade, Dublin and Livermore have been working to construct a 1.5-mile road extension between Dublin Boulevard and North Canyons Parkway to improve local traffic flow and traffic along I-580, and public transit, reduce carbon emissions and provide cleaner air, better access destinations like Las Positas College, and provide a faster route for 911 emergency vehicles.

But with a price tag over \$150,000,000, neither City could move forward.

Measure X allows this long-awaited road to be built, without the hefty cost to the taxpayers' bottom line.

Your Yes on X vote would enable a very small amendment to the Dublin Open Space Initiative for the sole purpose of allowing the road to be built. Previous actions taken by Dublin voters to restrict residential development will still be upheld.

Yes on X permits the City of Dublin to accept a donation of land that will be dedicated to road development; including bike lanes, pedestrian access, and creating new trails, with 100 acres of environmental, wildlife habitat, endangered species, and open space protection; retaining the open space buffer between Dublin and Livermore.

To secure these amazing community benefits at no cost to taxpayers, Yes on X will allow limited commercial — not residential — development rights on the adjacent 80 acres, providing East Dublin with access to high-paying jobs and local services other Dublin neighborhoods already have.
