



“Archeology” from the **Wallis Ranch Public Art Collection**, Eric Powell, 2016

As part of the Wallis Ranch Community, artist Eric Powell designed a series of art pieces that would be installed throughout the development. The series is inspired by the locations history and landscape. At the entry way of the community, in Wallis Ranch Community Park, is “Archeology” a 4 piece sculpture inspired by tools used on the ranches. In other, privately owned areas of the Wallis Ranch Community, are entry gates and a series of 3 benches that can be found on the walking trail and in back of Antone Pavilion, inspired by the shapes and patterns of native grasses. Lastly, there are the two sculptural screens inspired by vintage steel objects that were found on the property. The screens can be found mounted on the outside of Antone Pavilion.
